## Claims for Increase

- DBQs may be necessary but are always relevant
- Focus on relevant evidence gathering
- Appropriate DBQs for the increase conditions
- Avoid blanket VAMC requests
- Private medical, MTF, and Vet Center
- Relevant to issue claimed (ex. Paragraph 29,30)
- Avoid raising VA's further duty to assist
