"C&B 101"





The supreme authority of a department is vested in the department convention. Decisions of a department between department conventions are made by the DEC.



- Departments must annually elect a commander, sr. vice commander, one or more jr. vice commanders and shall elect or appoint an adjutant, state inspector and treasurer as outlined in Article 8, Section 8.3.
- Officer Reports submitted within 10 days.
- Changes throughout the year requires a new Officer Report.



- Annual Financial Reports must be submitted prior to September 30th in accordance with Article 8, Section 8.4.
- All departments must file with National.
- Income over \$300,000 requires a CPA Review.



- Districts within a department and the state atlarge chapter are not chartered entities and have no authority or powers as per Article 8, Section 8.7.
- No fundraising and no financial accounts.




- Fundraising activities are governed by Article 15, Section 15.2.
- Disciplinary action is outlined in Article 16 and NEC Regulation 6.
- Incorporations and affiliations are controlled by Article 17.
- Departments control and monitor the activities of their local chapters in accordance with NEC Regulation 8.



C&B 101 - Chapters

- Chapters must adopt and maintain its own bylaws as outlined in Article 9, Section 9.1.
- Chapters must annually elect a commander, sr. vice commander and one or more jr. vice commanders. An adjutant and treasurer must be elected or appointed.
- Chapter Officer Reports must be submitted within 10 days to the department and National Organization as per Article 9, Section 9.2.
- Changes through the year requires a new COR.





- Initial membership of a chapter is governed by Article 11, Section 11.2. Transfers are governed by Article 11, Section 11.8.
- Incorporations and affiliations are controlled by Article 17.
- Use of membership information is strictly controlled by Article 19, Section 19.2.



C&B 101 - Chapters

- Fundraising activities of chapters are governed by Article 15, Section 15.3
- Annual Financial Reports must be filed by September 30th each year as per Article 9, Section 9.3.
- All chapters must file with their department. Chapters with more than \$10,000 income must file with National.
- Chapters over \$300,000 must have CPA Review.
