## Navajo Code Talkers

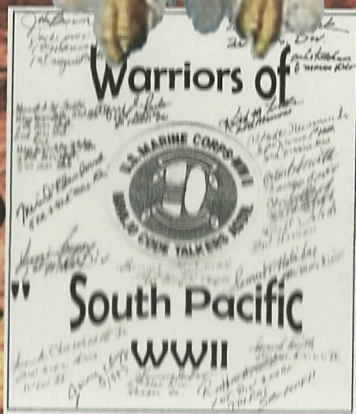
