
The Gainesville Fisher House Foundation is dedicated to bringing a "home away from home" for veterans, military members and their families during one of the most stressful times: a medical crisis.

that enables family members to be close to a loved one at the most stressful time -- during hospitalization for an illness, disease or injury.


On the cover:


