Information for Service Officers

Eligibility

Eligibility for interment in the Idaho State Veterans Cemetery mirrors National Veterans Cemetery eligibility requirements. Spouses and Dependent Children may also be interred in the Cemetery. The decedent does not need to be a resident of Idaho.

Requirements can be accessed via the web at: http://www.cem.va.gov/eligible.htm. The Veteran or Next-of-Kin may also contact a Benefits Counselor directly at 1-800-827-1000.

Pre-Registration

Pre-registration allows a Veteran to establish in advance, his/her eligibility for interment in the Idaho State Veterans Cemetery, and is intended to simplify and assist the Next-of Kin at the time of death.

It is the responsibility of the Veteran, Veteran's family or estate to provide the Cemetery with appropriate documentation in order to be interred. A Form DD-214 or equivalent discharge document must be submitted during the pre-registration process or at the time of a request for interment. When pre-registering a Spouse, a copy of the Marriage License must also be provided. Pre-registration of a Dependent Child requires proof of dependency.

When reviewing the pre-registration form, please note that this form is not a contractual agreement obligating the Veteran to interment in the Cemetery. It is not intended to override decisions made as a result of estate planning, Next-of-Kin authorization, or contractual agreements with Funeral Homes. Therefore, though we ask that the desired interment type be indicated on this form, it is not an obligation or guarantee, it merely allows us data for site planning.

Military Records

A Form DD-214 or equivalent discharge document must accompany submitted forms, as the absence will delay the pre-registration process, and, if not pre-registered, may affect the ultimate outcome of the decedent's final resting place.

Application for Interment

The "Application for Interment" form is when the decedent (Veteran or eligible Spouse/Dependent Child) is to be interred in the Veterans Cemetery. This form provides the Cemetery with the necessary contact information required to schedule interment. If not already pre-registered, a Form DD-214 or equivalent discharge document as described above must accompany the form in order to establish eligibility. Likewise, if not already pre-registered, spousal interments will require a Marriage Certificate and Dependent Child interment will require proof of dependency.

Individuals who submit a pre-registration application are subsequently provided with a letter confirming their eligibility for interment and are advised to file it with their other important documents. A confirmation number is referenced on the letter and allows the Cemetery Office to easily access the Veteran's eligibility file and enables the Office to immediately start the interment process. If the family is unsure if the Veteran or eligible spouse has been pre-registered, please call the Cemetery Office. Please be aware that the Cemetery cannot proceed with interment scheduling without proof of eligibility.

Fees

The basic interment fee for eligible veterans, spouses and dependent children is \$300 each. Upper tier casket interments are available upon request for a fee of \$600 per person. The Cemetery Office files each month with the Veterans Administration for the \$300 veteran plot allowance to cover the basic interment fee for eligible veterans. Associated funeral expenses and preparation are not included and are incurred by the Veteran's family or estate. If the Veteran is eligible for additional benefits <u>other than the plot allowance</u>, a VA Form 21-530 should be completed, indicating in Part II that burial was in the Idaho State Veterans Cemetery, and by not completing Part III (draw an "X" through this section).

Interment of the Spouse is in the same site as the Veteran. Inscriptions for both the Veteran and the Spouse/Dependent will reside on the same marker. All fees are due to the Cemetery at the time of interment. The Cemetery is unable to accept fees at the time of pre-registration. Some funeral homes may incorporate this fee into the overall cost of the Veteran's plan during the pre-planning process. The Cemetery does not recommend or discourage funeral homes from collecting Cemetery fees in advance. At the time of interment, the Cemetery will accept payment from either source.

Interment Sites and Markers

Casket interments are provided an in-ground site that includes an upright, gray granite marker and liner. For cremation interments the following options are available:

- · A columbarium niche that includes an inscribed, granite marker;
- An in-ground cremation inurnment that includes a flush-to-the-ground inscribed, granite marker;
- A scattering garden, set in a natural draw of the Boise foothills, with an inscribed marker in memory of the deceased.

Though families may choose their interment type, grave site selection is at the discretion of the Cemetery. Normally, the grave site is adjacent to one preceding it chronologically. As indicated above, the area located by the Flag Assembly area, atop the Cemetery is available for casket interment at an additional cost. Again, as sites cannot be selected, determination of the individual's final resting place will be made at the time of interment and additional fees collected at that time.

The Veterans Cemetery is responsible for securing headstones and markers for individuals making the Veterans Cemetery their final resting place. "In Memory" markers are also available in most instances to Veterans whose ashes have been scattered elsewhere and have yet to be memorialized in a cemetery. For individuals interred in private cemeteries, it is still the responsibility of the funeral homes to assist with the ordering of government headstones and markers using form VA Form 40-1330.

Interments


Committal services are conducted Monday through Friday between the hours of 10:00 am and 3:30 pm. All services are held in the Committal Shelter, as the Cemetery does not have a chapel. The Committal Shelter has been beautifully designed to provide a place of respectful remembrance. The Shelter provides limited protection from inclement weather, seating for the immediate family and ample standing room for others. Because of safety concerns, the Cemetery does not permit graveside services.

Military Honors

The Cemetery Office coordinates all Military Honors for those Veterans interred in the Cemetery. Honors include the playing of Taps, folding of the flag and its presentation to the next-of-kin. An Honor Guard detail of at least two members of the Armed Services are provided for the interment service of the eligible Veteran. For Veterans who retired from the military, a rifle volley is also provided.

Flags for presentation to the Next-of-Kin are provided by the Funeral Home as the Cemetery does not have a supply of flags. Flags can also be secured from designated US Post Offices by completing VA Form 21-2008.

Cemetery Location





The Cemetery is located north of Hill Road, east of Horseshoe Bend Road, adjacent to Dry Creek Cemetery.

The Cemetery shares the entrance gate with Dry Creek Cemetery, thus the grave sites that are seen upon entrance are part of Dry Creek Cemetery, not the Idaho State Veterans Cemetery.


To reach the Cemetery, continue straight and follow the red-white-blue flag signs. The Cemetery gates are on the left just past the Administrative Offices.



The Cemetery is open for public visitation from 8:00 am to sunset, 7 days a week. The Administrative Office is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm.

Pre-Registration - Completing the Application -

<u>Pre-registration</u> allows a Veteran to establish <u>in advance</u>, his/her eligibility for interment at the Idaho State Veterans Cemetery. There is no cost for pre-registration and it does not obligate the Veteran to be interred at the cemetery. Pre-registration is intended to simplify and assist the Veteran's next-of-kin at the time of death.

The interment fee for eligible veterans, spouses and dependent children is \$300. Interment fees for eligible veterans are paid by the Department of Veterans Affairs. Associated funeral expenses and preparation are incurred by the Veteran and/or family.

Please complete the application as instructed below:

- Check the "Pre-registration of Veteran" box and select "Interment Type." Eligible spouses may also be pre-registered at the same time as the Veteran, if so desired (see below).
- REQUIRED DOCUMENT
- Complete the "Veteran's Information" and "Service Record" sections of the form. Please note that the "Service Record" information listed on this application is not in lieu of providing the Veterans Cemetery with a copy of <u>Form DD-214</u> or other equivalent discharge document. A copy of either of these documents <u>MUST</u> be included when submitting this application. Failure to provide the required service record document will delay processing of the application.
- If at the time of pre-registration, it is felt that a person other than the eligible Veteran should be designated as the point of contact, please complete the "Contact Information" section.
- REQUIRED DOCUMENT
- Complete the "Spousal Information" if the eligible spouse wishes to be interred in the Veterans Cemetery. A copy of the **Marriage License MUST** be included when submitting this application. Failure to provide a copy of the Marriage License will delay processing of the application.
- In certain circumstances, dependent children may also be eligible for interment. Please contact the Veterans Cemetery Office for more information regarding dependent children.
- The person completing the application should sign and date the form. Please
 indicate the relationship to the Veteran. It is recognized that in certain cases the
 Veteran may require assistance and not be the individual completing the application.

- Interment Information -

Veteran Burial Benefits

Eligibility for interment in the Idaho State Veterans Cemetery mirrors National Veterans Cemetery eligibility requirements. There is no requirement to be a resident of the state of Idaho.

The interment fee for eligible veterans, spouses and dependent children is \$300. Interment fees for eligible veterans will be paid by the Department of Veterans Affairs. Associated funeral expenses and preparation are not included and are incurred by the Veteran's family or estate.

Casket interments are provided an in-ground site in the main lower tier of the Cemetery that includes an upright, gray granite marker. Upper tier casket interments are available upon request for an additional fee.

For cremation interments the following options are available:

- A columbarium niche that includes an inscribed, granite niche cover;
- An in-ground, garden niche, cremation inurnment that includes a flush-to-theground inscribed, granite marker;
- A scattering garden, set in a natural draw of the Boise foothills, to include a location for an inscribed marker in memory of the deceased.

Establishing Eligibility



In order to determine eligibility the <u>veteran's Form DD-214 military discharge</u> <u>record must accompany this application</u>. If the decedent is the Spouse or a Dependent Child, a Marriage License or proof of dependency must also be submitted in addition to the Veteran's Form DD-214.

Scheduling the Interment

Once the Interment Application has been received by the Cemetery Office, a staff member will contact the individual designated on the application as the "Point of Contact." Services are held Monday through Friday between the hours of 10:00 AM and 3:30 PM. The Cemetery does not have a chapel. All interment services will be held in the Committal Shelter. The Committal Shelter has been beautifully designed to provide a place of respectful honor and peace. It provides seating for the immediate family as well as protection from inclement weather. Because of safety concerns, graveside services are not available.

Military Funeral Honors

Military Funeral Honors are coordinated by the Cemetery. Honors include the playing of Taps, folding of the flag and its presentation to the Next-of-Kin. An Honor Guard detail of at least two members of the Armed Services is provided for the interment service of the eligible veteran.

Headstone/Marker Ordering

Interment type determines whether an upright headstone, flat marker or niche cover will honor the decedent's resting place. Inscription length and capacity varies for each marker type and are subject to Veterans Administration regulations. The Cemetery Office will work with the individual designated on the application as the "Point of Contact" to discuss details of the inscription.



- COMMITTAL SHELTER USE -











The *Committal Shelter* provides an opportunity for family and friends to pay tribute and honor to their loved one. The Shelter serves as a place of gathering and is used in lieu of a graveside service. It is beautifully designed, provides seating for the immediate family, and is partially sheltered from the elements.

The Shelter is available for use Monday through Friday between the hours of 10:00 AM and 3:30 PM. The Cemetery Staff schedules all Committal Services. Families are able to use the Shelter for a period not to exceed 20 minutes.

Military Funeral Honors are coordinated by the Cemetery. Honors include the playing of Taps, folding of the flag and its presentation to the Next-of-Kin. An Honor Guard detail of at least two members of the Armed Services is provided for the interment service of the eligible Veteran. In addition, a Rifle Salute is coordinated for a Retiree.

The Committal Shelter has a podium with sound. If music is desired, families may bring a CD/Tape player as electricity is available. The US Flag and Idaho State Flag are set up prior to the service. For the eligible Veteran, the appropriate Service Flag is also displayed. For cremated remains, a draped table is set up for urn placement, as well as for flowers and pictures if so desired. An easel is available upon request. Eight chairs are set up for seating of the immediate family.

Food, smoking and pets are not allowed at the *Committal Shelter*, or anywhere on the Cemetery grounds.

On the day of the Committal, family and guests are to first assemble in the *Cortege Assembly Area*. This is the area located to the immediate right, after entering the Cemetery gates. Various signs are posted to guide guests to this area. Vehicles are to pull up to the most forward point and wait for a member of the Cemetery Staff to lead the entire cortege to the *Committal Shelter*. This assemblage and escorting is important for traffic flow.


Please ensure family and guests are prompt, as services are often scheduled back-to back and the *Committal Shelter* use cannot exceed 20 minutes.

- FLORAL REGULATIONS -



The Cemetery staff will place up to three floral arrangements, which accompanied the casket or urn at the time of burial, on the completed grave. Natural cut flowers may be placed on graves at any time of the year. Flower vases are available for Cemetery use and are located in the numerous green bins found throughout the grounds.



Flowers will be removed when they become unsightly or when it becomes necessary to facilitate cemetery operations such as mowing.



Artificial flowers are not permitted on graves at any time as their presence interferes with grounds maintenance. No glass or ceramic vases or pots are permitted. Again, only the vases provided by the Cemetery may be used.

Christmas wreaths, but not grave blankets, may be placed on graves from December 1 through January 20. They may not be secured to headstones or markers.



One small American flag may be placed at the gravesite. The flag may not be attached to the marker. The flag will be removed by cemetery staff when it becomes unsightly.



Permanent plantings, statues, vigil lights, stuffed animals, breakable objects, and similar items are not permitted on the graves. The Idaho Division of Veterans Services does not permit adornments that are considered offensive, inconsistent with the dignity of the cemetery, or considered hazardous to cemetery personnel. For example, items incorporating beads or wires may become entangled in mowers or other equipment and cause injury.



Recoverable items removed from gravesites will be held for one month. Such items may be claimed at the administration building. If they remain unclaimed, they will be disposed of.







Avenue of Flags Program

- HEADSTONES & MARKERS -

General Information

Interment type determines whether a headstone, flat marker or niche cover will honor the decedent's resting place. Inscription length and capacity varies for each marker type and are subject to Veterans Administration regulations and Cemetery Director's approval.

Mandatory Information:


(1) Name, (2) Highest Rank Attainted, (3) Branch of Service, (4) Date of Birth, (5) Date of Death; More than one Branch of Service is permitted, subject to space available.

Optional Items:

(1) Emblem of Belief, (2) War Service, (3) Personal Achievement Awards, all of the aforementioned subject to space available.

Additional Items:


A personalized inscription, terms of endearment, a nickname are example inscriptions, provided space is available. For example, "Our Beloved Poppy" or "Lovingly Called Dutch" may be inscribed as well as civilian credentials or accomplishments.

Spousal Inscriptions:

For upright granite markers, space is reserved on the reverse side of the marker for the Spouse. Should the Spouse pass before the Veteran, the spousal inscription with the Veteran's military information will be indicated on the front of the marker. Subsequently, when the Veteran passes, the marker is reordered and the spousal information transferred to the back of the marker.

Spouse name and dates are inscribed on the first two lines of the flush to the ground markers. The Veteran's military information follows. Remaining lines are available for optional inscription if desired. When the Veteran passes, the marker is reordered with the Veteran's information.

Niche covers are inscribed with the Veteran's military information absent date of birth and passing. The last two lines are used (at minimum) for the Spouse's name and dates. When the Veteran passes, the niche cover is removed and sent out to update the existing inscription, unlike the other markers.



Idaho's Limited Wintage Silver Medallion - Series Two -



"A Sacred Trust"

The Series Two "A Sacred Trust 2004" medallion was released on July 22, 2004 and is now available for purchase. The sale of these one ounce silver medallions will help fund the maintenance and operation of the Idaho State Veterans Cemetery.

The coin includes the image of the Idaho State Veterans Cemetery with a lone bugler. Idaho was the last state in the Union to establish a cemetery in honor of veterans.
