The following is a short list of some of the activities DAV Chapter #1, MPLS is involved with on a ongoing basis:

- 1) Fall Forget Me Not fund raising (Nov 10 & 11, Jerry Foods Edina & Eden Prairie MN
- 2) Golden Corral (national level event) fund raising on or about Nov 13, 2023 Maple Grove
- 3) OMNI Brewing Co. Vets appreciation event on or about Nov 11, 2023
- 4) Spring Forget Me Not fund raising on or about 17 & 18 May 2024
- 5) MPLS VAMC hospital visitation, 4th Sunday of the month 12:00 Noon
- 6) VAMC food shelf program (in current development, details to follow)
- 7) December Holiday meal served to the residents of Fort Snelling UPPER POST Vet Housing
- 8) Monthly support to Hastings Vet Home suppling laundry soap for resident to use
- 9) Partner with Every Third Saturday to conduct Veteran outreach to homeless vets in MPLS
- 10) Provide funds for MPLS Vets Home recreational therapy and events
- 11) Provide funds for MPLS VAMC to serve coffee to patients and family in waiting areas
- 12) Provide fund to Fort Snelling Memorial Rifle SQD for supplies and uniforms for military honors at Fort Snelling National Cemetery
- 13) Provide funds to veterans in need of emergency assistance, e.g. unpaid medical bills, utilities pending disconnect, paying of medical transfers of vets from Hospitals / nursing homes to new housing arrangements
