


DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS





October 24, 2020

The regularly scheduled meeting of the DAV, Somerville Chapter 16 was held on Saturday, October 24th 2020. Our last meeting was a virtual one in August. This one was in-person. We did not meet in March, April, May, June, July, or September because of Coronavirus restrictions. Those rules also affected our planned fund drives and events at Lyons VAMC. The room was secured, and our colors were posted by our Sergeant at Arms. Our meeting was called to order at 10:00 am by our Commander. The result of a roll call of Officers was 6 present and 2 excused. Total attendance was 26. Other Commanders that were present 0. There was one guest.

Regular business:

The Commander stated we had contacted the Geiger Foundation, and received \$ 3000 donation check.

If anyone needed a copy of the monthly e-postcard extras were on the table. He announced there will not be Rock and Roll sponsored event at Lyons VAMC this fall due to COVID 19 lock down. We will be in touch with VA Lyons hospital for future events.

We continue to assist veteran organizations, which need help. We have received requests from Operation Chill Out, Project Help, and Independence for veterans. Kevin from Operation Chill Out has requested assistance for their winter program. They have asked for \$ 500. The chapter approved the request. Independence for Veteran's needs \$ 250. VA Lyons needs items and we will donate \$750 for that. Dudley House (YMCA) needs clothing and toiletries. We will budget \$ 250 for them. The Womens Treatment Unit luncheon for New Years costs approximately \$ 800. The chapter voted to make donations totaling approximately \$2,500-\$3,000 dollars. Motions (1st by Jim Cousins, 2nd Doc Wilson) for these donations were passed by all members.

The Commander participated in a Zoom meeting which covered operations at the DAV Dept of NJ. The Department circulated their annual booklet. The Department will conduct more chapter inspections this year. If you need Chapter clothing contact Doc Wilson for information and ordering. This will be cash in advance. The commander discussed our donation of an all-in-one computer to Kevin Murphy from Operation Chillout. The DMV is mailing out Veteran Parking and regular Handicapped Hang Tags. These can be done by mail.
