Service Officer Report

Burial benefits for eligible veterans include a gravesite in any of 134 national cemeteries with available space, opening and closing of the grave, perpetual care, a headstone or marker, a burial flag and a Presidential Memorial Certificate at no cost to the family. Some veterans may also be eligible for burial allowances. Cremated remains are handled in the same manner and with the same honors as casketed remains. Burial benefits for spouses and dependents buried in a national cemetery include burial with the Veteran, perpetual care and the spouse or dependent's name and date of birth inscribed on the Veteran's headstone at no cost to the family. Eligible spouses and dependents may be buried even if they predecease the Veteran. For more info or specific details contact Chapter Service Officer Johnson 267 254-9097

Veterans enrolled in VA health care programs have health coverage that meets the new Affordable Care Act's (ACA) standards. ACA does not change VA health benefits or veterans' out-of-pocket costs. Federal Leave Act of 2015

The Wounded Warrior Federal Leave Act of 2015 was signed into law November 5, 2015 and provides up to 104 hours of sick leave to any new Federal employee who is a veteran with service-connected disability rated at 30% or higher.
