We accomplish this by ensuring that veterans and their families can assess the full range of benefits available to them. Our Chapter has 1,401 members with 25 to 35 active volunteers. Also, we process veteran's disability claims, process disaster relief claims, conduct information seminars, assist with housing, resume preparation, and job placement.
