The new VA policy regarding FREE CELL PHONES: Free cell phones are issued the third week of the month by Tina Lewis VA Representative (901) 205-3345 to eligible veterans in the Cafeteria on the 2nd floor at the Memphis VA Medical Center at 1030 Jefferson Ave, Memphis, TN 38104. **IMPORTANT:** First you must obtain a letter of eligibility from the VA Hospital Eligibility Department on the 1st floor.
