No Onsite Emergency Care Services at the American Lake Division of VA Puget Sound

Dear Veteran:

It is important that our patients, as a matter of safety, understand that there are no emergency services available at our American Lake Division. Please call 911 if you feel you have a life threatening medical emergency, or go to the nearest emergency room in your community.

At our American Lake Division, we do have an urgent care clinic. The urgent care clinic is for ambulatory patients with an illness or injury that requires professional attention in a Doctor's office setting, and who believe their condition is not life threatening, but whose treatment cannot wait more than 24 hours without the condition becoming worse. The urgent care clinic is not a substitute for emergency room care. It is also not a good substitute for meeting routine primary care needs

Urgent Care Services at American Lake:

Effective February 1, 2010, hours for the Urgent Care clinic at American Lake are Monday through Friday, 8:00am – 6:00pm with no weekend, evening, or holiday hours.

Primary Care at American Lake:

Patients are encouraged to schedule Primary Care appointments Monday through Friday, 8:00am – 4:30pm for their general health care concerns and to discuss non-emergent health care needs.

Primary Care at American Lake will continue to expand to give patients better reliance on Primary Care for their routine health care needs rather than utilizing Urgent Care for this purpose.
