The Walk Across America begins at Duvall County War Memorial in Jacksonville, Florida and will take Hunsucker through eight states, ending at the Balboa Park War Memorial in San Diego, California on Memorial Day.

A pace-car, fully decked with patriotic memorabilia and remembrance of the wars, will follow Hunsucker during the trip.

Hunsucker will visit veterans' medical centers and outpatient clinics interviewing disabled veterans, doctors, nurses, family members and the public.
